What are we looking for?

As part of Rhubarb Festival 2026 (20th – 22nd Feb 2026) WX is seeking proposals from artists to design and create a **colourful**, **fun selfie station/area** for visitors to celebrate the **Rhubarb Festival**.

Commission Details

- **Purpose:** A vibrant, interactive installation where visitors can take photos of themselves celebrating Rhubarb Festival.
- Specifications:
 - o Height: approx. 1.5–2m
 - Floor covering area: max. 2m²
 - Must be easy to pack down and store (ideally flat-packable)
 - Durable construction (MDF or similar materials recommended)
 - Must include the words "Wakefield Rhubarb Festival" prominently in the design
 - The station can be an individual frame, or could even be multiple elements to make a 'set'... let your imagination run wild we would love to hear your creative ideas!
- Style: Bright, playful, and eye-catching
- Fee: Up to £2,500 inclusive of artist's time, materials, and installation.
