Wakefield Exchange is an indoor meeting and events venue.

The venue is in Wakefield City Centre.




The venue hosts **events** such as:

- Live music
- Art & Exhibitions
- Film Screenings
- Workshops
- Talks
- Comedy nights







The Venue is **open** 

#### Monday and

**Tuesday** 9:00am to 6:00pm food and beverage. The Shed (main hall) is closed.

Wednesday 9:00am to 6:00pm

Thursday and Friday 9:00am to 10:30pm

Saturday 10:00am to 10:30pm

Sunday 10:00am to 4:00pm



This is the step free access entrance.

There is **level access** and **auto doors** into the building from under the **canopy**.







This is the **ramp access entrance.** There is **an auto door.** 

This entrance is on **Union Street.** 

There is also **step access** here.

This is the Main Hall.

The hall has **coloured** lighting.

There is a **stage.** There are **video projections** on the wall.

There is **music** playing in the background.







Head into the main hall and turn left.

You will see the Food and Beverage area.

You can buy **Food and Drink** here.

There is a **bar** where you can buy alcohol and soft drinks.

There are places to sit.

This area may be **busy** and **noisy**. You may wish to wear **ear defenders.** 









There are **male and female toilets.** These are in the **Main Hall** on the **ground floor.** 

There is a **baby changing unit** in the **Female Toilets**.

This is in the first cubicle.







There is a **changing place** in the **Main Hall** on the **ground floor.** 





There are **toilets** on the **ground floor** in the **Food and Beverage area.** 

There are two **gender neutral toilets** on the right.











There is a **disabled toilet** at the end of the corridor.

There are **stairs** and a **lift** in the **Food and Beverage Area**.

Head upstairs to the **Mezzanine Level.** There is more seating up here and food vendors.







This door leads to the **meeting** rooms.



There are **portable hearing loop** devices. Please ask a member of staff for help.

You can use our **WiFi for free.** To do this you need to:

- turn your phone's WiFi on
- choose WX Guest WiFi
- the Username is guest
- the Password is wxevent
- tick a box to accept our terms and conditions
- choose 'connect'.







The closest **disabled parking** is at:

- Borough Road car park
- Carter Street car park
- Trinity Walk Shopping Centre car park
- Ridings Shopping Centre

**Service dogs** are welcome in all areas of the venue.

Well-behaved dogs on leads are welcome in the Main Hall and Food and Beverage.

Only service dogs are able to enter the meeting rooms.









Our **staff** wear a **blue** uniform. You can ask them questions about the venue. You can ask them for **help** if you need it.
